Dear Parent/Guardian

As you are aware, previous advice regarding the arrangements for returning to school in January has changed again over the Christmas break. From Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January, only vulnerable children and the children of key workers will attend school, please ensure that your child is in full school uniform if attending this provision. During this week all other students in years 7-11 will be learning remotely.

The students in year 11 will return to school on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January for face to face teaching, during this week students in years 7-10 will continue to learn remotely at home. From Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January all further students in years 7-10 will return to school for face to face teaching.

During remote learning students will need to follow their normal timetable and teachers will be live streaming lessons and setting work on Google classrooms. Students who do not have access to technology at home will be provided with a work pack, which must be completed and brought back to school the following week. A reminder that from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January we will be starting back on Week 2 of our timetable.

There is an external music examination for 38 year 10 students on the morning of Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January. The students involved must attend school for their examination and report to their normal year 10 entrance.

We are currently working to plan and set up the testing of students at school in line with Government advice and will update you with further information regarding this during the course of this week.
