LIST OF ACTIVITIES/SUBJECTS:

PE Games (rounders) - Pupils learned about the rules of rounders through fun and innovative games. They learned how to work as part of a team and developed various skills, such as throwing, catching and batting. Alternative bats and balls were used for differentiation.

Climbing Wall - Pupils were taught a variety of techniques in relation to belaying. Belaying is a variety of techniques climbers use to create friction within a climbing system, particularly on a climbing rope, so that a falling climber does not fall very far. They were also shown and taught how to climb up the wall using different routes.

Outdoor (Forest Schools) - Pupils were shown how to make a fire, to toast marshmallows, build dens and other activities which involved working as part of a team in outdoor surroundings.

Music - Pupils worked on how to create their own music piece using Logic Pro on the apple mac, they also learnt how to play the ukulele and make their own instrument.

Geography - Pupils knowledge was developed with regards to the environment and the importance of recycling and reusing materials and they all created a project piece using recycled materials.

History - Pupils were taught about the Second World War. As part of the lessons pupils were shown how to make models relating to this period such as weapons, boats, model soldiers etc.

Science - Pupils created various colours using acids and alkalis. They also created slides using paper and marbles, to demonstrate an invisible force known as gravity.

Dodgeball - Pupils worked as part of a team to be the ultimate dodgeball champions. Hand eye coordination, dodging and teamwork were some of the skills developed during their sessions.

Singing - Pupils performed as part of a group to form a choir learning different harmonies to various current pop songs.

Cooking - Pupils created a dessert which involved developing different skills to produce a dessert they could take home with them.

Meditation - Relaxation and breathing techniques were covered allowing pupils to recharge, relax and to empty their mind.

Arts and Craft - Pupils created a piece of art work based around the four school values, love, charity, respect and community, using various resources and materials.

Literacy - All staff were involved and all pupils received a book, which they could pick. Pupils were put in groups at the start of the week and remained in the same group throughout. The books remained in school during the summer school programme and each child was allowed to take them home at the end of the week.

Break and lunch was provided each day for all of the pupils.
